

Let there be light

> NATURAL AND ARTIFICIAL LIGHT IMPACTS THE WAY WE SEE COLOUR.

Most homes have a dark corner that lacks the precious natural light we all crave. Very often in Irish homes this is the hallway or a north-facing room.

While it might seem a good idea to go for the brightest tint possible in a dark space, this is not always the best move. Lighter tints and whites are bright because they reflect natural light. If there is not enough natural light to begin with then the brightest tints wonit add to it.

Always consider the function of the space. If you have a dark hallway, bear in mind you only pass through this interior. Choosing a colour that will welcome you and add personality is more important than making your hallway bright.

Make a feature of one wall in the hall. A deeper colour on the high wall going upstairs is always a good idea as it helps mask handprints. Freshwater Pearl on one wall with Papyrus throughout the rest of the hall will spread some light.

If you have a dark bedroom, here are some tricks you can use to add light. Painting furniture white, adding mirrors and reflective

surfaces and restricting a deeper colour to just one wall, for example behind the bed, creates a cosy feeling.

Remember a snug bedroom might be more conducive to relaxation and sleep Green on one wall and Calico on the rest of the room.

DON'T BE AFRAID TO USE DARK COLOURS IN YOUR HOME

There is a misconception that painting an entire room a dark colour will make it feel small, but actually it can have the opposite effect. Step out of your comfort zone to complement the dècor you already have and choose a strong unique shade to showcase your personal style.

#### Some tips for using dark shades

Donít pick your wall colour in isolation. Select it in tandem with the colour of something else in the space like a curtain, rug or accessory so the colour looks connected.

Donít let the size of a room stop you from using rich, bold colours. Deep colours blur the edges of walls, creating an illusion of an endless and expansive wall. Stick to dark colours on the walls, lighter furnishings and linens to balance the room.

Whether itis a bespoke chair or a textured throw, place bright accent colours in a dark room. This redirects the focus to the forefront of the room, allowing the walls to

disappear and act simply as a backdrop. Select everything with intention. Donít clutter. Itis all about quality over quantity and thatis key to getting the balance right.

Metallics work wonderfully with dark neutrals such as copper, brass, chrome and gold especially in the role of lighting.

If you are nervous about using dark shades, start by painting a downstairs toilet or just one wall such as alcoves in your living room or the wall behind your bed.






